MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS

- 2. Verifiable experience as construction manager for at least five (5) projects in Nigeria valued at over №500 million each
- 3. Demonstrated experience managing projects with specialized facilities similar to university requirements (laboratories, lecture halls, etc.)
- 4. Registered with relevant professional bodies including Council for the Regulation of Engineering in Nigeria (COREN) and/or Nigerian Institute of Quantity Surveyors (NIQS)
- 5. Evidence of compliance with the Public Procurement Act 2007 requirements
- 6. Documented anti-corruption policies and ethical business practices
- 7. Proof of financial capability to execute projects of similar magnitude

- Stakeholder engagement strategies (faculty, administration, students, community)
- Due diligence on prospective contractors and subcontractors

Construction Phase

- Provide full-time field coordination with qualified Nigerian personnel
- Manage all construction contractors in the field
- Regular cost monitoring and control
- Construction scheduling with contingencies for local challenges
- Manage shop drawing and submittal process
